SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Papers, Panels, Briefings, Demonstrations and Workshops Accepted (please specify):

- All 200 word abstracts must be submitted electronically in MS Word format to the SAFE Office at safe@peak.org. The SAFE office will coordinate all review and acceptance. **All data on the last page of this document is required and must be submitted with your abstract submission. No abstract will be accepted without it.**

- Technical Paper Abstracts should include Introduction, Methods, Results, and Discussion sections.
- Panels, Briefings, Demonstrations, and Workshops should contain a paragraph describing the issue and its importance, followed by a description of the program or piece of equipment and how it is used to address the issue. Panel Sessions should outline the topic or scope, number of presenters by name and affiliation, and the panel chair. Panel sessions may list “tentative” speakers or papers for acceptance but these must be finalized before the deadline.
- You will be notified when your submittal is accepted, rejected, or if revisions are required for acceptance. If your submittal is rejected, you may resubmit with corrections and/or changes. Your paper will be scheduled based on the type of paper and content, i.e., technical paper or briefing.

AUDIO VISUAL PRESENTATION AT SYMPOSIUM:

Presenters should bring their final, formatted MS Power Point presentation, electronically saved on appropriate media (memory stick, CD etc.) directly to their session at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled start. The program allocates time between sessions to accommodate loading the session’s presentations immediately before the start. All authors are required to attend the morning Author’s Coffee to meet and coordinate with the SAFE Technical team, the session moderator, and session co-presenters. This morning meeting will be held from 7:00 AM – 7:45 AM.

Note: If you have any technical issues, please contact your moderator (as listed on your session scheduling letter and in the program) or the SAFE Technical Chair at your earliest opportunity and certainly prior to the beginning of your session. We will do our best to resolve your problems. There is not always enough time between sessions to correct presentation issues. Please plan accordingly.

The following equipment will be available for all technical sessions:

- A laptop/projector and screen
- Podium Microphone
- Lighted Pointer
- Applicable screens and microphones

PUBLICATION IN THE 2010 SAFE PROCEEDINGS:

- **For approval of any technical presentation, a manuscript or set of power point slides will be required for publication in the 2010 Annual Proceedings.**
- All technical presentations including papers, panels, workshops, demonstrations, etc. presented at the Symposium are eligible for inclusion in the proceedings from the symposium. The proceedings is published in CD format and the production company requests both a CD containing your presentation, along with a hard copy of same.
- **Your final material for publication in the SAFE Proceedings is due at the SAFE office no later than Friday, November 19th. Submit early if possible.**
